Our Aims...

The St Augustine's Priory Parents' Committee aims to raise additional funds to provide the school with many extras that would otherwise not be available from the annual school budget.

Our function is mainly fundraising, but we also believe that it is important to nurture and entertain our children through social and fun events whilst fundraising for the benefit of the whole school.









Fundraising Events...

We organise and run many fundraising events throughout the year. These include our Famous 'Fabulous Fireworks' Display, the Christmas Fayre, Quiz and Murder Mystery Evenings as well as our Summer Ball/Summer Fayre.

The Committee usually meets once a term and sets up smaller working groups to organise individual events.









How is the money spent?...

Funds raised by the Parents' Committee are intended to provide 'extras' not already provided by the school's main income – often 'fun things' that make learning more interesting and exciting.

For example, here are a few examples of projects we have proudly funded in the past...

The resurfacing of the netball court, providing equipment for the four laboratories in the Science Block, interactive whiteboards where needed, equipment for the Nursery in the Clock House, the school mini bus, provision of playground equipment in the Prep Playground, the school hockey kit and contributing to the hockey posts.

Our recent purchases included the New Vertis Galleon in the Prep Meadow, audio-visual equipment in the Chapel, the school allotment and chicken pen, samba band equipment and outdoor gym equipment.

Who decides on spending the funds raised?...

The Student Council, class representatives, the Sixth Form and teachers all have the opportunity to put forward proposals for projects on which to spend the funds. The St. Augustine's Priory Parents' Committee and the Headteacher then decide at the meetings how best to make good use of the allocated funds.
