<p>COGMED Memory Course</p> <p>We will be using an online software program called Cogmed, which aims to increase working memory and processing skills. The benefits of the program can include not only increased working memory, but also improved reasoning ability, comprehension skills and mental arithmetic. It is an intensive course, and ideally pupils will complete a 35 minute session 3-5 times per week, but at least one of these could be done from home once they are familiar with the program (it works on any PC and on ipads). The program can be completed in as little as 5 weeks, but is likely to take rather longer depending on the number of sessions the girls do each week. Each pupil will need to complete a memory assessment before starting the course to ensure that it is appropriate to their needs.
