Our Sixth Form

Our Expectations

- Girls working to their best ability in class, during study periods and at home and using feedback productively.
- Demonstrating excellent levels of attendance and punctuality. Two incidents of lateness in one week will lead to a Friday detention.
- Meeting deadlines set by teachers and proactively flagging any issues.
- Treating teachers with respect and the appropriate level of formality eg calling them by their correct names.
- Uniform to be worn correctly or girls will be sent home to change (see details below).
- Mobile phones are only to be used between 12.45pm and 1.45pm and inside the Priory 6 common room. Any breach of this will result in phones being confiscated and sanctions put in place.
- Maintaining safe and sensible online behaviour when at school or at home.
- Keeping the Sixth Form area clean and tidy.

Uniform

The following must be worn from Monday to Thursday during term time (Fridays are Dress Down day):

- Uniform skirt no shorter than just above the knee.
- White blouse or shirt (long sleeved t-shirts are not permitted).
- Uniform cardigan (hooded tops are not permitted)
- Black leather low heeled shoes (not canvas).
- Suit jackets must be worn to and from school, during Mass, assembly and school events such as the Carol Service.
- Simple jewellery and light make-up are permitted.

Attendance and Punctuality

- It is vital that girls maintain outstanding levels of attendance and punctuality.
- Please support us in this at home by encouraging full attendance and facilitating your daughter leaving the house in good time for a prompt arrival at school at 8.30am each day.
